The Kelly Paraeducator Competency Assessment (KPCA) is our proprietary evaluation application **designed to collect observational data on individual paraeducator skill competencies**. Created by our experienced internal special education expert, the KPCA is used to measure skill sets within the seven standards which represent best practices for paraeducators.

The KPCA tool consists of a rubric that assessors use to rate an individual paraeducator's skills—from emergent to superior. The data collected enables the supervisor and paraeducator to create a prescriptive training plan and provides monitoring of skill development progress.

Within the app, assessors can access real-world observable scenarios that demonstrate the standard being evaluated. The seven standards are:

- Understanding and respecting student development and differences
- Understanding the importance of and working effectively in the educational environment
- Understanding and implementing requirements for the curriculum (math, reading, science, etc.)
- Administering assessments and collecting data
- Using organizational and planning strategies, both individually and in an educational team environment
- Demonstrating ethical and professional knowledge and actions
- Appropriate communication and collaboration with all stakeholders.

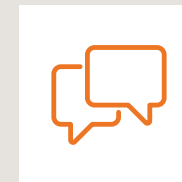
